## Zechariah, Elizabeth, and John the Baptist: Preparing the Way for Jesus

Every year many of us spend the weeks leading up to Christmas preparing. We put up festive decorations, plan menus, buy presents, and orchestrate schedules. ## **REFLECTION** After listening, consider the following questions:

- What lessons do you draw from the story of Zechariah's encounter with the angel Gabriel and of God blessing Elizabeth and Zechariah with a child in their old age? How does recognizing these truths help prepare our hearts to celebrate Christmas and Jesus' second coming?
- In segment 2, host Scott Hoezee compares Zechariah's song in Luke 1:67-79 to a psalm. Think about a significant moment in your life and God's role in it. What would you include if you were to write a song like Zechariah did? What would you praise God for? In verses 76-79, Zechariah points forward to what will come. What would you say in your song about what will happen in the future?
- Why do we need to be prepared in advance for Jesus' coming?
- How does John's baptism of repentance help prepare us for Jesus' baptism into new life?
