

God Redeems

The biblical theme of redemption is unique to Christian theology and sets Christianity apart from other religions. Join us as we trace God's story of redemption from Genesis through the Old Testament to the ultimate sacrifice of our Savior Jesus Christ. Together, we'll learn how our loving God sent his only Son to accomplish our salvation, without expecting anything from us first. We'll discuss distinctives of depravity, election, and grace as articulated by the confessions in the Reformed faith tradition. Reflecting on the transformative power of God's redemptive work, we'll talk about living redeemed lives as we go about our daily lives.

- How does the concept of grace differ from the idea of earning salvation?

REFLECTION After listening, consider the following questions:

- How does God's call to Abraham in Genesis 12 initiate the theme of redemption? How does redemption become more specific in God's covenant with David and meet its fulfillment in Christ?
- In Ephesians 1:3-11, Paul describes our redemption as part of God's eternal plan. How does Darrell's description of God's "Plan A" help you better understand this passage?
- Galatians 2:20-21 speaks of being "crucified with Christ." How does this truth impact or affect how we live out our faith?
- Ephesians 2:1-5 describes humanity's spiritual condition before and after redemption. Reread these verses and consider: How does this passage emphasize the depth of God's mercy?
