

# I Believe in God, the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is the third member of the Trinity. Just as fully God as the Father and the Son, the Holy Spirit is unseen, yet very active, empowering individual believers and the Church alike. Both the Old Testament and New Testament acquaint us with the person and work of the Holy Spirit. Discover the scriptures that spur Christians to confidently declare with the Apostles' Creed "I believe in the Holy Spirit."

- What has this study of the Holy Spirit helped you to better understand about God?
- In segment 2, hosts Scott Hoezee and Dave Bast discuss the Spirit's role in helping us become more like Jesus. Reread [Galatians 5:22-25](#). What fruits has the Holy Spirit blessed you with? Which fruits do you think the Holy Spirit is cultivating in your life right now to help you become more like Christ?
- In segment 3, Scott and Dave discuss how the Holy Spirit equips us with gifts that glorify God and help us point others to Jesus. How has the Spirit gifted you to serve God's kingdom?
