

# I Believe in the Church, God's Community

Is the Church a building, a group of people, or some other institution designed by humans? Study the scriptures to gain a biblical understanding of the Church and the communion of saints. Learn why the Apostles' Creed declares we believe in "one, holy catholic Church" even though the Church is full of imperfect people and splintered denominations. Discover why Christians talk about the small c "church" and the big C "Church." Dig into God's Word with *Groundwork* and learn why it's impossible to be a believer without being connected to the body of Christ.

**AWARENESS** Before listening reflect on what you already know or understand about topics we'll cover in the episode.

- What is the difference between a church and the Church? How has your experience with a particular church shaped what you believe about the Church?
- Do you think it is important to belong to a church? Why or why not?

**REFLECTION** After listening, consider the following questions:

- How does the knowledge that you are not only called into a relationship with Jesus, but also into a relationship with his *community* impact your faith life and practice? How does this truth affect your perspective on church?
- Reflect on the three beliefs expressed about the Church in the Apostles' Creed: one, holy, and catholic or universal. Which characteristic is the easiest for you to believe and recognize? Why? Which one is the most difficult to believe or recognize? Why?
- When have you witnessed the holiness of the Church? When has a church failed to be holy or distinct from the surrounding culture?
- How is the "communion of saints" different than the saints celebrated or revered in the Roman Catholic Church? How has or might reflecting on the communion of saints strengthen your faith?
- Where have you witnessed glimpses of the communion of saints, the *koinonia*, the church as it should be, the invisible church?
- How can you increase your awareness of the Church-at-large, the communion of saints, the Church around the world, the Church past and present?
- In what ways does your vision or understanding of the church need to grow?
