

Living as Citizens of God's Kingdom Now

When we pray, “Your kingdom come...on earth as in heaven,” we demonstrate our trust in what we cannot see. We cannot fully see God’s kingdom around us yet, but our prayer is also our calling to reflect God’s reign in our daily lives. His kingdom is already here, and by studying Scripture, we discover what it means to live faithfully in the kingdom now.

REFLECTION After listening, consider the following questions:

- In segment 1, hosts Scott Hoezee and Darrell Delaney discussed the characteristics of God’s reign: righteousness, peace, joy, and *shalom* that are rooted in the Spirit and expressed in community. Where do you see Christians living this way well?
- In segment 2, Darrell and Scott showed us that, as Darrell said, “Living the kingdom is not always dramatic.” But when we choose acts of kindness, humility, sacrificial love, and obedience to God’s will, we’re living the kingdom. What can you do to remind yourself of this truth in your daily life?
- How would you answer Darrell's question, “What would happen if our church or community started to take this kingdom vision very seriously?”
- What situations and brokenness in our world do you think have us and all creation “craning our necks” and eagerly anticipating the full inbreaking of God’s kingdom in our world?
