

# Paul's Journey to Rome: Proclaiming Jesus Everywhere

As the apostle Paul continued to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ in Jerusalem, crowds became increasingly contentious, and he was once again arrested and beaten. During the long series of trials that eventually led him to Rome, Paul seized every opportunity to share his testimony and preach the gospel. As we study Paul's journey to Rome, we too can gain confidence and readiness to share the good news of Jesus everywhere we go.

**REFLECTION** After listening, consider the following questions:

- Reflecting on the prolonged trials Paul experienced, host Darrell Delaney said, “Even though God didn’t cause the persecution that he was experiencing, God still got the glory out of it because he was able to tell his story and able to share the gospel in every situation.” Darrell insightfully points out that other people caused the persecution Paul experienced because they didn’t like his relationship with and teaching about Jesus. What are some of your life’s stories that you know were caused by others’ decisions but resulted in opportunities to glorify God and talk about Jesus?
- What lessons or encouragement do you glean from studying Paul’s prolonged legal battle and his speeches to Felix, Festus, and King Agrippa?
- In segment 3, host Scott Hoezee discusses Acts 27:35, “That is the Lord’s Supper, a sacramental meal taken by all who were onboard the ship...It was a life-giving meal just before the ship is utterly destroyed...what a great reminder of the presence of Christ in all moments of our lives, including...some of the most difficult moments of our lives, Jesus is there.” When has the Lord’s Supper assured you of the presence of Christ in a difficult season? What helps you continue to give thanks and honor God during the storms of life?
