

Preparing for the Light of the World

Jesus Christ is the ultimate light of the world. During Advent, we celebrate his birth and look forward to his second coming. Let's discuss what it means to prepare our souls for the hope and illumination that Jesus brings, and learn what it means to live in the light of Christ with expectation.

REFLECTION After listening, consider the following questions:

- In your favorite Advent or Christmas traditions, how apparent is it that the first step of preparing for Christ's birth is repentance?
- Where have you looked for hope in the wrong place? When has Christ offered you hope through a source you least expected?
- What situations feel scary or dark to you? How does it make you feel to remember God is willing to bring his love and light into our imperfections and messy situations?
- In segment 3, host Scott Hoezee reminded us that we are not passively waiting to receive the light of Christ when he comes again. Our waiting is active, and we share and reflect Christ's light for others right now. Host Darrell Delaney reminded us that we reflect the light of Christ through our love, our patience, and our forgiveness. Where in your life can you reflect the light of Christ through love, patience, or forgiveness?
