**REFLECTION** After listening, consider the following questions:

- Reflect on Irenaeus of Lyon's image of the triune God described by guest Sue Rozeboom in segment 1 (at 03:34). Mull it over, picture it in your mind, and perhaps even draw it. What makes this image powerful to you?
- In segment 1, hosts Darrell Delaney and Scott Hoezee discuss with Sue how our belief in the Trinity influences our worship services. For example, the songs, the gathering, the Lord's Supper, and the three-movement prayer of thanksgiving all reflect our trinitarian theology. Are there other ways you've seen the influence of the Trinity in your church and/or the Church universal?
- Think about how you usually pray. How do you see your beliefs about God and the Trinity reflected in the manner and words of your prayers?
- How do we bear the image of our Triune God when we participate in community with other believers?
