

# We are the House of God

The fundamentals of a well-built house help us to better understand our identity as the Church. Jesus Christ makes clear that the firmer our foundation, the more secure we will be when the storms of life come our way. Studying the image of the Church as the house of God will help us discover the true foundation of our faith life, both individually and as a body of believers, and teach how we should treat each other so that we can live our faith well together in community.

Can you think of a person who survived a stormy time in life because of their faith? What made their faith notable to you during that time?
- What has the concept of family taught you about your relationship with God and with fellow believers?

These rules are not meant to restrict us, but rather, to aid us as we live our faith well together in God-honoring ways. As you reflect on these two lessons a well-built house offers our faith, consider this prayer:

*Jesus, you are the Cornerstone. Make your Word a firm and immovable presence in my mind and heart. Send your Spirit to reinforce the foundations of my faith. Help me to see my fellow believers with your eyes. Open my eyes to the ways I can show love to all people, just as I desire to show my love to you. Amen.*
